Please note applications close on the 16th of August 2021.

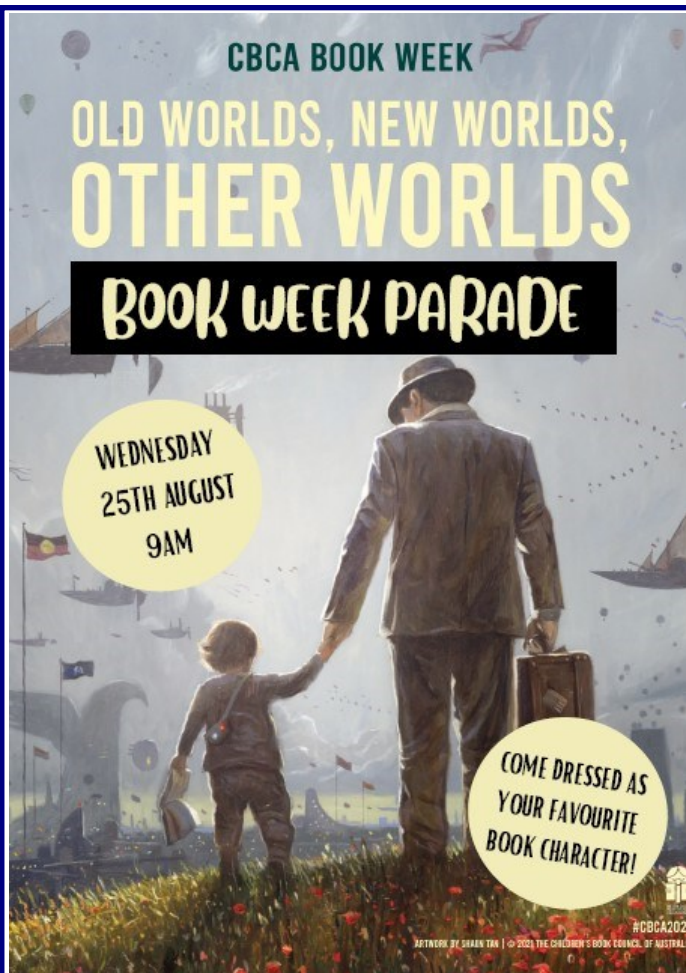
