SCHOOL SAVINGS BONUS

As shared with you previously, parents and carers of every child enrolled in a Victorian government school in 2025 will receive the one-off School Saving Bonus \$400 support.

By now, all parents will have received by email their child's voucher code (note this email will only go to the parent listed as Parent A on students' enrolment, not both parents). If you have not received your email from the department, please check your spam or junk folders and contact Patty in the office if needed. (The email will be from school.saving.bonus@education.vic.gov.au, with the subject **Your School Saving Bonus**.)

Unfortunately, the School Savings Bonus <u>cannot</u> be used for Stationary book packs. The main use that we see most of our Lockwood Students will be able to use if for are uniforms, camps and excursions. As all these items are managed internally in the school, we are still waiting on some clarification from the School Saving Bonus, but to use these funds in the school on the above items, you will need to allocate your funds to school activities and not the other options available. Further clarification will be sent out via compass when we receive confirmation.


At this assembly we will also acknowledge those families will be leaving our school community at the end of 2024. School Council are providing a BBQ for any families that would like to purchase food prior to the event.
